

Dear Sirs,

I petition the SEC to issue a rule stating that all publicly traded companies that terminate employees as a result of the president's vaccine mandate shall make public the number of employees terminated. For the purpose of this rule the number shall include, employees terminated, employees placed on unpaid leave, and those forced to resign. The company shall release both the raw number and the number as a percentage of total employment.

In addition to the total number of employees terminated, the companies should release data on the terminations broken down between unskilled labor, skilled labor, professional, and management. Again, this data should be both the raw number and as a percentage.

I believe the release of this information is necessary so that stockholders can assess the impact of the terminations on the company.
